 - Skills that you might need to reach your goal (for example, being comfortable with different kinds of animals, being able to talk to pet owners)
 - Evidence or artifacts that demonstrate your achievements or skills (include evidence that you will gather in the future as well as evidence that you already have)
 - Target date for getting the evidence into your e-portfolio
